

# MARCH 2023: No Fear! Little Flock

*Luke 12: <sup>32</sup> "Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom.*

Last month I reported on the January 15<sup>th</sup> Church Conference vote of Black Hawk-Bethlehem that approved disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church. This process will conclude mid-year after payment of the exit fee, a vote of approval at the UMC Wisconsin Annual Conference in June, and a final transfer of property and assets back to the re-birthing Blackhawk Bethlehem Church (BhB). Once that is all complete, BhB will be an independent, non-denominational church. The Disaffiliation Team led by Gene Unger continues the ongoing work of organization of the new church. The entire leadership covets your ongoing prayers as we make our way through the remaining steps, and as we seek to follow God's leading to fulfill His will and purposes for Blackhawk-Bethlehem today, and into the future.

Some of you may be wondering about the future of BhB, including the question of pastoral leadership. In November 2022, I informed you that I will be retiring as a United Methodist Pastor as of July 1, 2023. After much discussion, prayer, and discernment, Karen and I have agreed to continue as Secretary/Pianist and Pastor of BhB through June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024. In the meantime, the newly formed leadership will be considering whether to remain independent, or join another denomination in the future.

Like any adventure, this transition can be frightening and exciting all at the same time! I see the coming year as an opportunity for serious self-examination and re-awakening to the possibilities of God's Kingdom life in and through the people of this church community. I can imagine this as a season of revival; of hearts being (re)awakened to the reality of God and His desire for reconciliation and relationship with you, your neighborhood, and the world. If that doesn't both scare and excite you, I don't know what will!

As we "birth" a new church, here are some of the areas of emphasis for the coming year: home-study groups; additional spiritual formation for our youth; corporate prayer opportunities; strengthening traditional marriage & family; praise, worship & prayer; humility & holiness; deepening our relationship with Christ.

I know there are some who think the church is going in the wrong direction. And I also understand that some may no longer wish to be associated with BhB and will want to remove themselves from the Membership. Though it makes me sad, I respect that decision. I believe we all need to live according to our convictions and conscience. So, at the request of our UMC District Superintendent, I agreed to inform you that anyone desiring a transfer of Membership to another church may begin the process by notifying the church office with your request (608- 544-3991 or [bhbumc@gmail.com](mailto:bhbumc@gmail.com)).

Friends, I know change can be unsettling...fear of the unknown threatens to rattle even the most faithful followers of Christ. I also know that He who began a good work in you will see it to completion! He is our Rock on Whom we place all our hopes and fears!

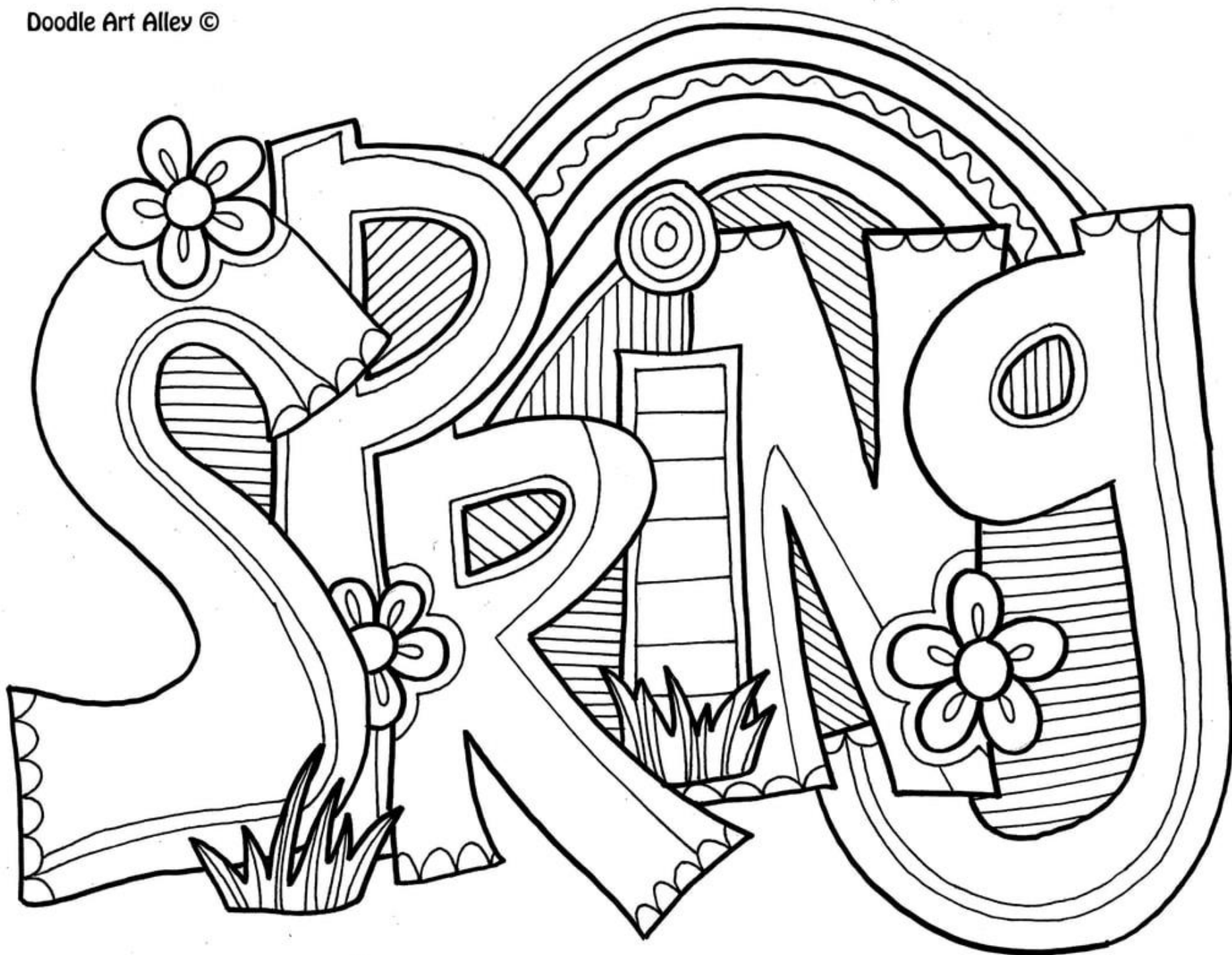

As I was cleaning out my files, I ran across an email from a friend who shared with me the following writing (author unknown):

**Dancing With God**

When I mediated on the word Guidance, I kept seeing “dance” at the end of the word. I remember reading that doing God’s will is a lot like dancing. When two people try to lead, nothing feels right. The movement doesn’t flow with the music, and everything is quite uncomfortable and jerky. When one person realizes that, and lets the other lead, both bodies begin to flow with the music. One gives gentle cues, perhaps with a nudge to the back or by pressing lightly in one direction or another. It’s as if two become one body, moving beautifully. The dance takes surrender, willingness, and attentiveness from one person and gentle guidance and skill from the other. My eyes drew back to the word Guidance. When I saw the G, I thought of God, followed by U and I. God, U and I Dance. As I lowered my head, I became willing to trust that I would get guidance about my life. Once again, I became willing to let God lead. My prayer for you today is that God’s blessings and mercies be upon you on this day and every day. May you abide in God as God abides in you. Dance together with God, trusting Him to lead and to guide you through each season of your life.
