I ask you to join me in pausing to give thanks for God's grace, and for leading His church throughout the decades (160 years in 2024), especially these past couple years of wilderness wandering resulting in our liberation to follow, worship, and faithfully serve Him. The wisest place to begin any journey is at the throne of God's grace; on SUNDAY SEPT. 10, 2023, beginning at 9:00 AM worship, we will hold a Service of Consecration.

CONSECRATION is defined as the transfer of a person or a thing to the sacred sphere for a special purpose or service. The word consecration literally means "association with the sacred". Persons, places, or things can all be consecrated to the purposes of God. The origin of the word comes from the Latin stem *consecrat*, which means dedicated, devoted, and sacred. **SANCTIFY** is a synonym for consecration, and is likewise, about God transforming a person, place, or thing and setting them aside for His holy purpose.

Join us on **SEPTEMBER 10th** as we participate in God's "setting apart" of Blackhawk Bethlehem Church. In recognition of this sacred occasion in our 159th church's history, we will break bread together after the service with a POTLUCK MEAL. We invite members and friends to bring a dish to share and enjoy the fellowship and food.

We praise God for calling us to take our place in His transformative, life changing, kingdom building business. May each of us enter this new adventure with excitement, anticipation, and awe of what God desires to accomplish in and through us. May we embrace Him as He sets us aside for His sacred and glorious work.
