Acts 14:²¹ They preached the gospel in that city and won a large number of disciples. Then they returned to Lystra, Iconium and Antioch, ²² strengthening the disciples and encouraging them to remain true to the faith. "We must go through many hardships to enter the kingdom of God," they said. ²³ Paul and Barnabas appointed elders for them in each church and, with prayer and fasting, committed them to the Lord, in whom they had put their trust.

I feel so very fortunate that in our late teens and early 20's, Karen and I were part of a non-denominational church with a discipleship culture. This group consisted of people of every age (not much different in size from our church community). The people were excited to gather often for worship and Bible study; learning, growing, praying, encouraging, and discipling one another in the love of Christ.

I remember my first visit to the church which gathered in the lower level of the Bob & Maureen Francis Family home. I was nervous! Even though the people were welcoming and made no claims to having reached Christian perfection, I knew they had a passion for Christ that I didn't possess. I knew they had a relationship with God that I wanted for myself. As this church community walked out their faith, they were humble people who recognized their desperate need of saving grace that Jesus alone can provide. Like Christ followers over millennium, they knew their only hope for this life (and eternity) was to surrender everything to Jesus. They oozed with joy as they navigated the treacherous minefields of life with an overwhelming confidence, love, trust, and dependence on the grace of Jesus Christ. They sought to be the church that God called them to be, at that time and in that location. At times it looked awkward and clumsy as they worked out their salvation with fear and trembling, yet they did so with pure hearts and motives. I wanted THAT! Following their godly example and loving direction, I made a choice: through the abundant grace, mercy and overwhelming love of the Father, and by the shed blood and sacrifice of the Lamb of God, I became a disciple of Jesus Christ. That decision changed my life.

And just like them, God desires us to be the healthiest possible version of His unique body, in THIS present time and place. Right where He has planted us. So, as we begin this exciting new year as Blackhawk Bethlehem Church, may we passionately seek to embody the fullness of the vision Christ has for us. Make no mistake: no church is perfect. But God's desire, will, and vision for His body are! Let us continue to press on in our pursuit of God's best as we embrace a disciple-making culture at BHB. I pray that none of us will fall short of the fullness of life God intends for us. Hear my heart as it echoes the words of Paul to the church in Corinth in his second letter (11:2) when he said: I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy for I promised you to one husband, to Christ...

WHAT IS THAT??? If you've wondered about the black metal rectangles hanging on each side of the altar, they are mounting racks for large-screen TVs. The TRUSTEES have been working out a plan to upgrade our Audio/Visual system and this is the first step of installation. With the help of a special donation from the Ladd Family and others, the Trustees purchased the TV units which will be tied into a system that will eventually be used to enhance the worship experience. Two 86" diagonal UHD smart TVS will be mounted on the adjustable arm mounts that can retract flat to the wall. They will replace the projector and pull-down screen currently used by pastor to display sermon power points. Future uses will include internet streamed videos and song lyrics. A smaller smart TV will also be mounted to the face of the balcony to be used as a monitor for the pastor and/or musicians. Once fiber optic internet is connected, computer upgrades will allow for worship services to be live streamed (instead of our current method of recording, editing, producing, uploading, and releasing). Stay tuned for updates on the progress and needs of this project.

IN CASE YOU HAVEN'T FIGURED IT OUT YET...Our way of collecting tithes and offerings changed a few months ago. Gone are the brass plates that we were accustomed to. With a bit of creative thinking, John Been fashioned a CROSS-shaped slot/box that is affixed directly to the shelf itself. Into this slot, you may drop your tithes and offerings. Thank you, Steve Mallon for donating the shelf, and thank you, John, for using your carpentry skills. It looks and works GREAT!
